The swimmer also gives permission to publish his/her performances, in particular the times and videos of the swimming technique, for marketing, analytical and other purposes of Swim Smooth Czech Republic, z.s. and Gabriela Minaříková, licensed Swim Smooth coach. I have been advised that I can withdraw this consent at any time.

By submitting this application, I give my consent to the personal data administrator (Swim Smooth Czech Republic, z.s.) for personal data collection, its processing and storage (for 5 years) according to Act 101/2000 Coll; this includes personal data provided on the application and amendments to this act, with regards to swimming training. This consent also applies in particular to my birth number. I further agree that the SSCZ will provide the above mentioned personal data, including the birth number, to the Central Register of Czech Swimming Federation (ČSPS), the Czech Sports Union (ČUS) and Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports (MŠMT) in accordance with Act No. 101/2000 Coll. I have been advised that the provision of personal data is voluntary and that I can withdraw my consent at any time.

Terms & Conditions of the Swim Smooth MASTERS Program

1. Swimming training (also referred to as "training") is provided by the staff of the provider (head coach, designated coaches / instructors).
2. The swimmer is obliged to inform the provider properly, truthfully and in a timely manner about the change of his state of health and not withhold any details.
3. The swimmer is responsible for ensuring that his / her condition of health is appropriate for the selected training. The Provider recommends the swimmer undergoes an initial medical examination of performance / stressful sport testing before starting the training and to repeat this examination periodically once a year.
4. The swimmer in the Masters group prepays a semi-annual subscription, which includes 18 training sessions, with an annual registration fee of 1200 CZK per calendar year. If a swimmer joins the training half way during the half, he pays a proportionate half-year subscription.
5. The provider recommends that the swimmer arrives at least 15 minutes in advance of each training session. The swimmer is always obliged to adapt his / her behavior to the swimming pool's operating rules before entering the swimming pool area. In the event of a delay, missed training or earlier termination, the provider is not required to replace the training.
6. A swimmer is not authorized to participate in training in the event of a disease that prevents him / her from participating fully in the training; And in the case of a risk of infection to the other participants and the provider's staff (coaches / instructors).
7. For unapproved absence of training, the swimmer is not entitled to any compensation. In the case of a repeated (twice) unacknowledged absence, the Provider is entitled to cancel the swimmer's membership, without compensation for unused sessions.
8. The swimmer is obliged to notify his / her absence by email, sms or by telephone without delay, even if no substitute training is available.
9. Replacement lessons will be arranged if the following conditions have been applied:
 - a. the apology was announced 24 hours prior to the lesson,
 - b. the swimmer has a pre-paid membership,
 - c. the same ability group lessons take place more than once per week, and there is space for the swimmer, as long as the group does not exceed the maximum number. It is possible to only reimburse the group to which the swimmer has registered, after consulting the trainer beforehand. Refunds within a different group are only possible if the swimmer is efficient enough for another group.
 - d. It is not possible to arrange substitute training if the swimmer uses all the training sessions for his performance.
10. The organizer reserves the right to modify the course program or location, or even cancel due to unforeseeable and unpreventable events, for which the Swim Smooth cannot be liable. In the case of cancellation, a class on an alternative date of the lesson will be offered or a 50% refund of the amount for the lesson if the provider failed to offer an alternative date. Absence on an alternative date does not establish entitlement to a 50% refund of the amount per lesson. In the case of a cancellation of the entire swimming course, 50% of the total amount for the remaining classes will be refunded.
11. The Provider is not liable for damages caused by wilful conduct of the swimmer or failure to comply with the instructions of the staff of the provider or pool operator.
12. The swimmer is liable for damages caused intentionally or negligently.

Cancellation Policy:

The paid subscription is non-refundable, and not transferable to other swimming lessons:

- a. For unused sessions;
 - b. In the case of health reasons on the part of the swimmer;
 - c. In the event, that the provider decides to terminate a swimmer's training for gross violation of the rules of the swimming training (e.g. destruction or damage to the property of the provider or pool operator, inappropriate / disrespectful/ rude behavior towards other participants of the swimming course, to coaches/instructors, etc.) or violation of these Terms and Conditions.
 - d. If the swimmer has taken a trial training hour before enrollment;
 - e. The annual registration fee or its proportional share will not be refunded regardless of the date and manner of termination of the swimming lesson.
13. Before enrollment it is possible to arrange a trial training date. In the case of a trial training is arranged, the payment for each such training is then calculated proportionally in the full tuition fee. The swimmer takes note that a trial training date may, under one of these conditions, take place maximum two times. In the event a swimmer attends two trial lessons and then enrolls on a course, it is then not possible to cancel.
 14. In the case of a higher number of interested swimmers who wish to enroll, the Provider is entitled to prioritize candidates who order the entire swimming term and pays a subscription for it in full and in advance. The provider is also entitled to give priority to the person interested in training more than once a week and has the ambition to race and represent the swimming club.
 15. The Provider further advises the swimmer that when the goods are purchased through the provider, a contractual relationship is established directly between the swimmer and the producer / supplier of the goods. All rights and obligations (in particular liability for defective performance or warranty rights) are agreed without further involvement of the provider. The manufacturer / supplier of the goods was advised of this circumstance. In the case of ordering goods through the provider, this legal representative gives consent to the provider with his / her representation to handle the contractual relationship, including the inspection of equipment. In other matters, the swimmer is obliged to act directly with the manufacturer /supplier.
 16. The provider is entitled to these Terms and Conditions without the prior consent of the swimmer to make changes. The changes will be sent by email to the swimmer at the e-mail address given on the application. If the swimmer does not agree with the changes, he / she is obliged to inform the provider within 30 days of the notification of changes to the General Conditions. In this case, the contract will be terminated by depletion of prepaid lessons, under the current General Terms and Conditions.
